Heather Albin - High Performance Coach Swimming (Performance) joined the School of Sport from Dundee in 2011.

Heather swam with City of Dundee SC in the 80's when she moved to Dundee from Kilmarnock, she then moved into coaching taking up the post of Head Coach in 1988 at City of Dundee SC. In 2009 Dundee City Aquatics was formed by the coming together of 2 local clubs, Heather took on the role of Performance Coach in July 2008 where she stayed until starting in Glasgow in August 2011.

Through her career in the sport Heather has been involved in the National Squad set up for over 20 years, she has been Head coach of the Tayside swim team and Midlands District. Heather has consistently produced swimmers of a high standard and has produced swimmers who have gained medals at the Commonwealth Youth Games and made finals at the Commonwealth Games.



Heather works mainly with the S5/6 pupils at the School of sport and help support the programme for the S3/4 pupils alongside Bill Ruddock.

Jamie McKinley – Assistant High Performance Swimming Coach

Jamie was a former pupil at the Glasgow School of Sport and has been a member of City of Glasgow swim team since he was 8 years old initially as a swimmer and currently as a Coach. During his swimming career, Jamie competed at both British and National level.

He started coaching in 2012 and the following year was appointed as Junior Development 1 coach in the West of the City and experienced success with swimmers winning the mini league.

Jamie is currently working within the West with the Clubs Junior development 2 squad.

Jamie has recently been appointed to the role of Assistant High Performance Swim Coach at Glasgow School of Sport and his main focus will be working with the swimmers in S3 and S4.
